

# Lesson - 21

Bible portion : 1 Samuel 17

Memory Verse : 1 Sam 17: 47

Objective : If we trust in God from our childhood, He will help us.

Teaching Aids : Pictures of:

Individual soldiers and soldiers in group; old man-to-man battles; old and new weapons (sword, spear, shield, sling, stone, rifle, etc); hills and valleys; round pebbles; flocks of sheep grazing in meadows; David upon Philistines having fallen at the strike of stone
