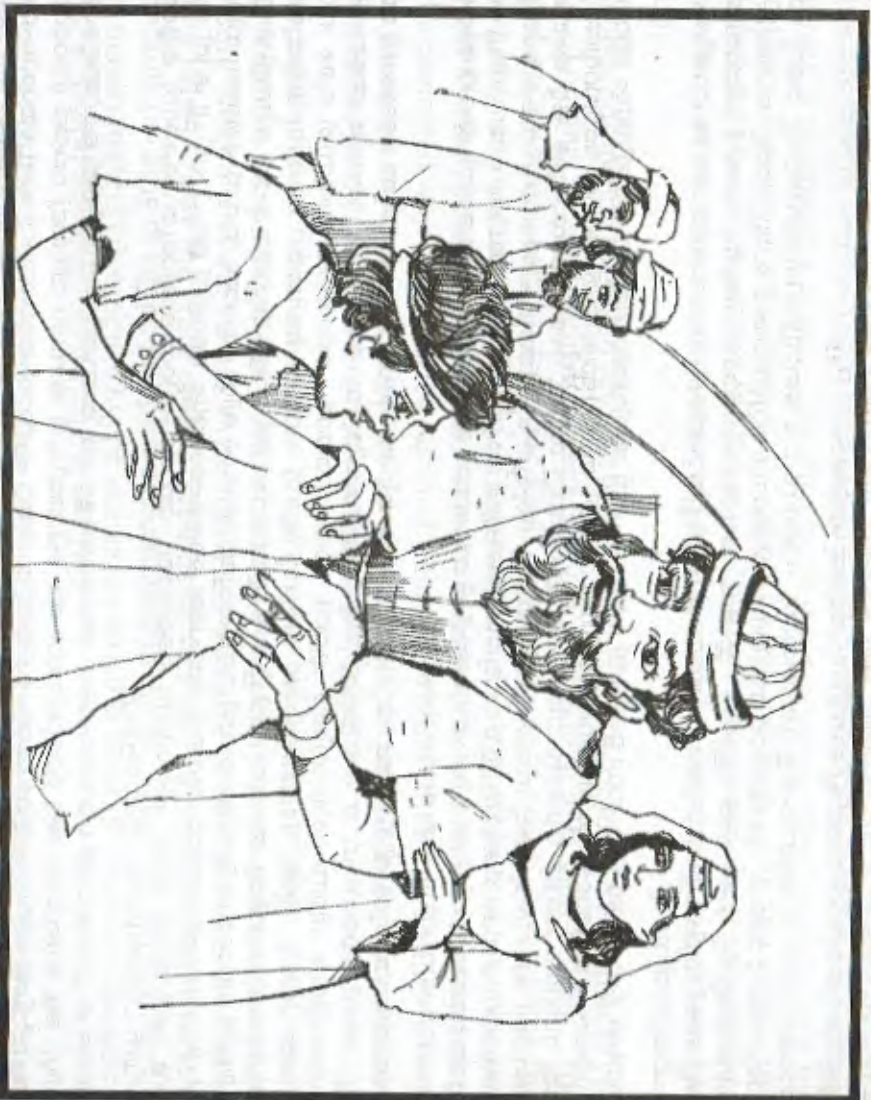

**Reading portion: Genesis chapters 37, 39, 40, 41 42.**

There was a big family- A father, mother and thirteen children who loved and cared for each other. The father specially loved one son the most. Therefore his brothers blamed him and troubled him. Today we will learn the story of Joseph, whom God lifted up as he was a God fearing child.

Jacob had 12 sons. He was very rich and had animal wealth too. Joseph and Benjamin

were the sons of his wife Rachel. His brothers used to go far to tend the flocks and also for other works. The father made a richly ornamented robe for Joseph. At times Joseph too went out to help his brothers with the work.

One day Joseph went along to bind sheaves with his brothers in the field. That night he saw a meaningful dream. He dreamt that his sheaves stood upright and his brothers' sheaves bowed down to it. Again he saw a dream. The sun, moon and eleven stars bowed down to him. Because of his two dreams and the robe his father gave Joseph's brothers were jealous of him and waited for an opportunity to trouble him.

Jacob sends Joseph to go and see if all is well with his brothers. Joseph was then 17 yrs old. Looking for his brothers, Joseph arrived at Shechem and then Dothan. His brothers saw him coming from far itself. Saying to each other, 'here comes the dreamer', they plotted to kill him. They caught him, stripped him of his robe and threw him into a cistern that had no water in it. Later they sold him to the merchants who came that way. Joseph cried out loudly. But his brothers didn't give ear to his cry. They tore his robe, dipped in goat's blood and took it to their father. They misled their father by saying that a ferocious animal killed Joseph.

Meanwhile the merchants took him to Egypt and sold him to Potiphar, an official of that country; Joseph did all the work in his house. But his master's wife put Joseph in prison. Joseph who did not do anything wrong was able to interpret the dreams of some prisoners by the grace of God. Later as he was able to interpret the dream of Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, Joseph was honoured in Egypt. What was impossible by the magicians and wise men of Egypt, was made possible through Joseph by the grace of God. Joseph was appointed minister of Egypt.

**Message: Those who love and obey God, will be honored by God. Their dreams will be fulfilled.**

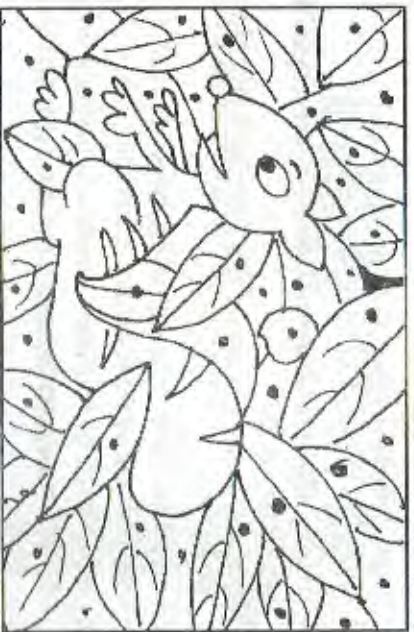

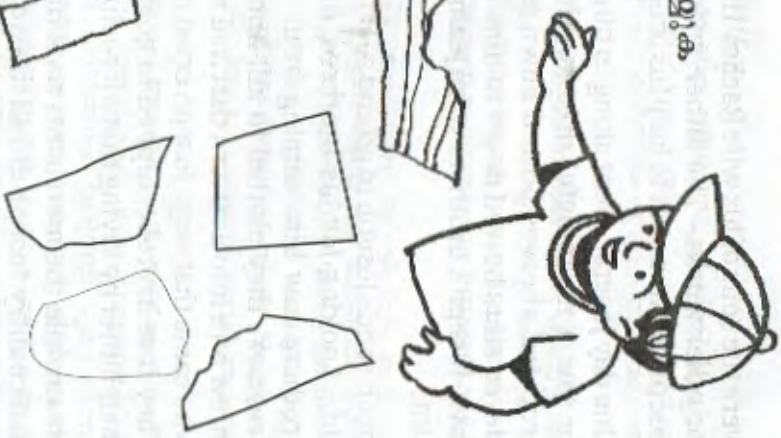
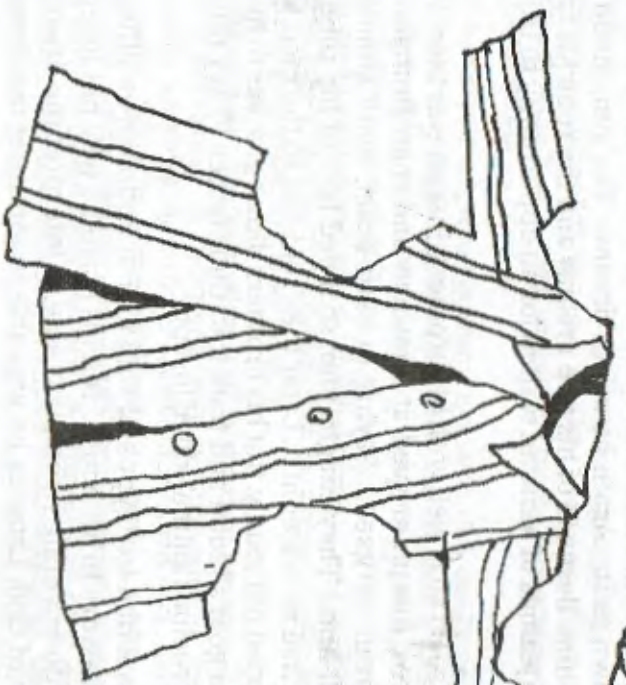
